



Hampshire Fare Membership Agreement *for Producers and Retail and Hospitality Members*



1. The member will be bound by rules and regulations relating to members, as resolved by the Directors, as a condition of membership.
2. The member undertakes to pay the subscription which the Directors have resolved to charge. If a subscription remains unpaid two months after the due date, an invoice and subsequent reminder having been rendered to the last known address, the Directors shall decide at the next Board Meeting whether the membership shall be regarded as lapsed.
3. The member will use his/her best endeavours to promote the aims and objectives of Hampshire Fare Limited and shall not do anything that prejudices or is in any way contrary to its interests. The Directors reserve the right to terminate this Membership Agreement at any time at their discretion.
4. Membership implies a commitment to the production and/or promotion of quality food, drink or craft within the county of Hampshire. Each Producer Member will do his/her utmost to maintain or improve the standard of all products for which he/she is responsible.
5. Members must hold adequate current public and product liability insurance. Evidence of such insurance must be made available when requested.
6. Membership of Hampshire Fare Limited does not entitle a member to use the name of Hampshire Fare Limited by way of endorsement, advertisement or promotion of any product in any way whatsoever.

7. Members are expected at all times to comply fully with their obligations under relevant Codes of Practice, any Act of Parliament, Order or Regulation.
8. When exhibiting at an event organised under the overall identity of Hampshire Fare Limited, members must complete an application and comply with any requirements set out therein. Where a charge is to be made for participation in such an event, payment must be made in advance of the event.
9. The member acknowledges that Hampshire Fare Limited, its Directors, officers and staff shall not be made party to any contractual arrangements as between that member and any third party, whether expressly or by implication.
10. In granting membership, Hampshire Fare Limited does not act in any way as the agent of the member. Any sales promotion, advertising and sale of goods is, and shall remain, the sole responsibility of the member. Hampshire Fare Limited reserves the right to require any member to alter, remove or cease any form of sales production and sale of goods associated in any way with Hampshire Fare Limited that contravenes any Code of Practice, Act of Parliament, Order or Regulation, or brings, or is likely to bring, Hampshire Fare Limited into disrepute.
11. Hampshire Fare Limited reserves the right to seek reasonable information from members about the performance of their business. Hampshire Fare Limited undertakes to hold information in confidence and to release only in summarised form, for Hampshire Fare Limited as a whole, to providers of funding by way of grants etc.
12. On joining each Producer Member will be entitled to a £10 share in Hampshire Fare Limited and will receive a certificate to this effect.
